
Surgical Case: Adult Male. Full CLII div I with 8mm overjet and a deep bite with deep Curve of Spee. CLII skeletal with Wits of +8. Maxillary arch is skeletally normal and the lip profile position is good. Mandibular arch is skeletally retrognathic (~8mm).

Esthetically the mandibular body length looks too short and retruded.

Treatment Plan: Orthodontics (using the SWA) combined with a BSSO surgical procedure "mandibular advancement" by the maxillo-facial surgeon.







6th month: All teeth are bracketed/banded. The final stages of leveling with the SWA.







 $\textbf{10}^{th} \textbf{ month:} \text{ BSSO surgical procedure - mandibular advancement}$

14th month: **3 months after the BSSO surgical mandibular advancement.** Final finishings – 19x25 HA NiTi wires, segmented and 4mm delta elastics to settle in the occlusion. Before and after photos.

Retention: Fixed lingual wires from 3 to 3 plus removable retainers.
